Please note that preference will be given to Early Intervention staff presently working in the program and to individuals with experience working with preschool children with disabilities. Staff will work full days and will be paid per diem. Case load and staff schedules for this work will be determined by the Early Intervention Program Administrator based on the Early Intervention specially designed instruction for each child.
