Job Summary: The program will offer basic instruction in literacy, mathematics, science and the arts for those students who will be transitioning to kindergarten. The program will be offered at the following 16 sites. Staff adjustments may be made based on student enrollment.

The program will be offered 4.5 hours per day, 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday from July 12 through August 6, 2010. Teachers will work 4.5 hours a day (8:00 AM – 12:30 PM) Monday through Friday. The teachers will be compensated at their daily rate of 64% per day (4.5 hours) for 19 days. Staff will be provided 10 hours for professional development on July 8 and 9, 2010 and paid at the workshop rate of \$23.32.

Staffing will be adjusted according to student enrollment and staff will be notified by April 30, 2010.

Leaves of Absence will not be honored. If for some reason you must be absent during the time of this professional opportunity, please do not apply.

QUALIFICATIONS:

First preference will be given to teachers who **presently teach in the early childhood site**. Teachers who teach satisfactorily at an early childhood site in summer school shall have preference for hiring in a subsequent summer(s) at that early childhood site, provided that they continue to teach during the regular school year at an early childhood site. **Secondary preference** will be given to the grade level teachers from other schools.
